

## AnsaldoBreda wins EUR 50 million train contract in Turkey

AnsaldoBreda, a Finmeccanica company, has won a EUR 50 million contract, in partnership with the Turkish company Yapi Merkezi, to provide the municipal authority of Kayseri with a 17.5 km tram system comprising 31 stops and 22 trams.

Under the agreement, AnsaldoBreda will provide bidirectional, air-conditioned Sirio trams with a driver's cab at each end, which can transport 270 passengers and may be coupled together in multiple units.

This raises the number of Sirio trams being built in Italy and abroad to more than 250, and confirms the product's adaptability to customer demands, as well as the high-tech quality of AnsaldoBreda vehicles.

In 2004 AnsaldoBreda secured new orders worth EUR 815 million, while its order backlog rose to EUR 1,772.8 million.
