Pier Francesco Guarguaglini is Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Finmeccanica, the Italian leading high-technology group (51.026 employees and a consolidated turnover of 9,4 billion euros in the year 2004). The Group, which is quoted on the Milan Stock Exchange, operates in the following sectors: aeronautics, space, helicopters, defense, transportation, energy and information technology.

Besides Finmeccanica is the Italian shareholder of STMicroelectronics N.V., the third world group in microelectronics' sector.

- From September 1996 to April 1999 - Head of Finmeccanica's Defence Sector Businesses.
- From December 1998 to September 2000 - Chairman of the Board of Directors of ALENIA MARCONI SYSTEMS NV (a joint venture between Finmeccanica and BAE).
- From May 1999 to April 2002 - Chief Executive Officer of Fincantieri Cantieri Navali Italiani S.p.A.
- April 2002 - Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Finmeccanica S.p.A.
